This course is designed for participants to gain the necessary skills to plan, prepare and complete Dogging work.

The course runs over a 4 day period.

Day 1 & 2 Introduction to dogging theory. Students will be able to:

- able to determine the SWL of gear and materials
- select, maintain and inspect fibre ropes, chains, steel and wire ropes
- perform splicing techniques and demonstrate a number of bends and hitches
- sling, move and place loads
- directing cranes

Day 3 Practical sessions using a crane to perform lifts and setting up for lifts

Day 4 Workcover assessment to gain National Licence.

The course can be organized either at our training centre in Eden or at the workplace to suit your needs.
